Presenting a new artist activation this year, Phil Chang will create an unfixed photograph each day at 2PM with an unveiling on the opening VIP day of the fair. Using expired Kodak Kodabrome paper, the images will fade throughout the day. His corresponding exhibition *Process, Object, Residue* is currently on view at the Penumbra Foundation. Using expired fugitive and unstable materials, Chang interrogates art market operations, the economic implications of artistic production, and the value assigned to stages of the creative process.
