THE PHOTOGRAPHY SHOW PRESENTED BY AIPAD MARCH 31 – APRIL 2, 2023 CENTER415, NEW YORK CITY



NEW YORK –The Photography Show presented by AIPAD opens on Friday, March 31, and runs through Sunday, April 2, 2023, at Center415 on Fifth Avenue between 37th and 38th streets. A VIP Preview will be held on Thursday, March 30. The roster of 44 galleries includes members of the prestigious Association of International Photography Art Dealers known as AIPAD, recognized as the world's leading galleries of fine art photography, as well as an exceptional selection of emerging galleries new to AIPAD.

One of the most highly anticipated annual art fairs, The Photography Show presented by AIPAD, now in its 42nd edition, is the longest running and foremost exhibition dedicated to the photographic medium. The fair will feature fresh-to-market and museum-quality photography including cutting-edge contemporary, modern, and exemplary 19th-century photographs, as well as photo-based art, and new media.

PHOTOGRAPHY INSTITUTIONS AT AIPAD

Three photography institutions will be participating in The Photography Show this year. Visitors will be greeted by portraits on the façade of Center415 from the **International Center of Photography** (ICP). The images are from the current exhibition *Face to Face: Portraits of Artists by Tacita Dean, Brigitte Lacombe and Catherine Opie* on view at ICP at 79 Essex Street through May 1.

Aperture will present limited-edition prints by artists including Yto Barrada, Sara Cwynar, John Edmonds, An-My Lê, Will Matsuda, Adam Pape, Hannah Whitaker and Hank Willis Thomas. A pop-up store with newly released book titles will also feature signed copies by artists Gregory Crewdson, Justine Kurland, Susan Meiselas, Wendy Red Star, Shikeith and more. In partnership with AIPAD, Aperture will also offer a selection of books by artists whose work is on view with exhibitors across the show.

Fotografiska will feature a pop-up installation of works from the current exhibition *Hip Hop: Conscious, Unconscious,* on view at Fotografiska New York at 281 Park Avenue South through May 20. The show amplifies the individual creatives involved in the movement and surveys the women who trailblazed amid hip hop's male-dominated environment, hip hop's regional and stylistic diversity, and the turning point when hip hop became a billion-dollar industry that continues to mint global household names.

SPECIAL EXHIBITIONS



For the first time, AIPAD will present a special exhibition throughout the Show devoted to large-scale photographs. *Monumental Moments* will showcase more than 15 photographs from 12 participating galleries, highlighting the possibilities of scale in fine art photography. Among the featured artists are

Edward Burtynsky, Lissa Rivera, Sebastião Salgado, Flip Schulke, Rashod Taylor, Marjan Teeuwen, George Tice, Mickalene Thomas, Tony Vaccaro, and Michael Wolf.

In celebration of its 10th anniversary, **MUUS Collection** presents an exhibition of work from five photographers: André de Dienes, Fred W. McDarrah, Deborah Turbeville, Rosalind Fox Solomon, and Alfred Wertheimer. The exhibition showcases both iconic and lesser-known images, offering viewers a captivating selection from each artist's archive. MUUS Collection's mission is to seek out exceptional photographers whose work has been historically underappreciated, with the goal of presenting their distinctive work to new audiences.

AIPAD AWARD

The Association of International Photography Art Dealers (<u>AIPAD</u>) will present the annual AIPAD award to Mattie Boom and Hans Rooseboom, Curators of Photography at the Rijksmuseum in Amsterdam during the VIP Opening on Thursday, March 30, 2023. The AIPAD Award recognizes and celebrates visionaries who have spent their lives at the forefront of the field of photography.

AIPAD TALKS

A series of six in-person AIPAD Talks will feature prominent curators, collectors, artists, and journalists during the run of the show. Mattie Boom and Hans Rooseboom will kick off the series on Friday, March 31, at 1 p.m. They will be speaking about *Curating Photography at the Rijksmuseum in Amsterdam* with moderator Jean Dykstra, editor, Photograph Magazine.
